RULES & REGULATIONS (TERMS AND CONDITIONS)

General: These rules of the club are made to ensure that 'you' as a member have maximum protection for safety and health, and that we are able to provide you with a safe environment to train in. It is essential that everyone obeys and supervises the adherence to these rules and regulations.

Whanake Rangataua strives for excellence in all aspects of our teaching and training. Therefore, we expect that all participants (students, parents, guardians and instructors alike) strive to uphold and maintain these rules at all times.

- 1. Smoking is prohibited at all times (both inside the dojo and outside around the premise).
- Alcohol and drugs are prohibited at all times. Any member that consumes alcohol or comes to training under the influence shall not be permitted to train, and their membership will be reviewed.
- 3. Abusive language is not permitted at all times. Swearing is not permitted in the dojo.
- 4. Every member must show respect for the instructor of the dojo or any other senior grade student at all times.
- 5. Every member must have regulation uniform within 4 weeks of enrolling with the club.
- 6. Uniforms must be kept in a clean and well-maintained condition at all times.
- 7. Every member must be fully paid up with their training membership and grading fees. Fees are non-refundable.
- 8. Any member who commits an act that reflects poorly upon the club is liable to immediate expulsion.
- All property belonging to the club and/or training venue must be used with care. Members (or parents/guardians) will be liable to pay/replace any damage done to the venue, facilities, or property.
- 10. The clubs' style of karate is a 'body contact' sport. There is risk of injury. The club will not be liable for injury to any person, nor for damage to or loss of property belonging to any member or their families.
- 11. For health and safety reasons, all club members must ensure finger and toe nails are kept clean and short at all times, especially during any organized club training activity.
- 12. When visiting another Karate club / style / or even another one of our WRK dojo, members must present themselves to the head instructor of that club, state his grade and ask permission to be allowed to watch or train. This is considered good etiquette amongst Karate Clubs and Styles.
- 13. Privacy: The club may take photographs or video recordings of the students from time to time for use on our club websites or in other printed publications we produce. The club will only use images which are appropriate and of a respectful nature.
